

Multiplier Event at Hatemoğlu Elementary School, İstanbul, Turkey

There has been a half-day event on June 23, 2022 in İstanbul. The aim was to share the ENACT Project outputs with the Syrian and Turkish families, teachers, and students at Hatemoğlu Elementary School. The teachers and the families reflected on their experiences about intercultural communication, their actual experiences as migrants in İstanbul. They shared about the challenges they faced and the potential use of the ENACT App for cultural dialogues/exchanges between different cultural backgrounds has been discussed. The school administration has shared suggestions about how to deal with these challenges in the school context such as Turkish language courses for the parents, closer contact with the migrant students to encourage their studies in formal education.

A researcher representing the Ministry of Education Provincial Unit of İstanbul also presented her projects and ideas about the issues discussed.
